

Alfredo Berges President UNE

Alfredo Berges Valdecantos is the President of the Spanish Association for Standardization, UNE. He was elected for this responsibility by UNE's Board of Directors in December 2022, after serving as Vice-President since 2018.

He has been a member of the Association's Governing Bodies for nearly 40 years since its foundation and incorporation, and is currently President of UNE's Market Surveillance Observatory.

He is also the Director General of the Spanish Association of Lighting Manufacturers (ANFALUM) since its creation in 1981 and is a member of the Executive Committee of the Spanish Confederation of Metal Business Organizations (CONFEME-TAL) and the Board of Directors of the National Association of Capital Goods Manufacturers (SERCOBE), as well as founder and member of the Board of Trustees of ECOLUM.

In addition, he is a member of the Executive Committee and the Associations Committee of Lighting Europe. Mr Berges has also been Secretary General of CELMA.
