In addition, he has held various positions in different organisations, such as President of the Institute for the Economic Development of the Principality of Asturias, the Public Society for Tourism and Cultural Management and Promotion, and the Society for Foreign Promotion. He has also held the position of Vice-president of the Regional Society for Promotion, and has been a member of the board of directors of PYMAR (Small and Medium Reconverted Shipyards) and the Port of Gijón.
