Professor at Universidad de Castilla-La Mancha and Founding partner of DQTEAM, S.L. UCLM

Mr Piattini holds a PhD and Degree in Computer Science from the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid; as well as a Degree in Psychology from the Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia, and a Master in Computer Auditing and Master in Project Management. He is CISA, CISM, CRISC and CGEIT certified by the ISA- CA; and PMP by PMI. He also holds a Diploma in Quality by the Spanish Association for Quality, and is Secretary of the UNE's technical committee CTN 71/SC 7 - Software Engineering and Information Systems.

Mr Piattini is a Professor of Computer Languages and Systems at the Escuela Superior de Informática (ESI) of the Universidad de Castilla-La Mancha (UCLM), where he directs the research group Alarcos, specialized in Information Systems Quality and is a founding partner of several spinoffs: Cronos Ibérica S.A, Kybele Consulting S.L., DQTeam, S.L. and AQCLab, the first laboratory accredited by ENAC for quality assessment of software product and data.

He has been Director of the Joint Center for Software Research and Development UCLM-Indra, Coordinator of the Computer Science and Information Technology Area of the National Agency for Evaluation and Foresight (ANEP), and Director of the Institute of Information Technologies and Systems (ITSI) of the UCLM.

His merits and awards include: being among the 15 "Top scholars in the field of systems and software engineering (2004-2008)" and the 15 "Most active experienced software engineering researchers (2010-2017)", National Award to the Professional Career of Computer Engineer by the Federation of Associations of Computer Engineers of Spain, Gabriel Alonso Herrera Award of the JCCM to a research career, Grace Hooper Award by the Professional Association of Computer Engineers of Castilla-La Mancha (COIICLM) and Aritmel Award by the Computer Science Society of Spain (SCIE).
